<p>Create a propaganda poster persuading people to support the war</p>	<p>Find a war time recipe and have a go at baking some tasty treats!</p>	<p>Create a parachute for a soldier that would keep it safe.</p>	<p>Research rationing and write or draw a menu based on these ingredients.</p>
<p>Make do and mend! Can you turn old clothing into a new teddy bear? You will need scissors, a needle and thread.</p>	<p>Write your name using Morse code.
