Visit a local building or at- traction. Find 5 facts about the history of the building or site.	Carry out your own friction test. Can you rank 10 differ- ent materials based on their friction?	Research about Viking Runes. Write 5 words using runes in- stead of our alphabet.	Find 10 fascinating facts about Vikings. Can you display them in a unique or interest- ing way?
