Perryfields Primary PRU School Uniform Overview

Statement of intent

Perryfields Primary PRU believes that a consistent school uniform policy is vital to promote the ethos of the school and provide a sense of belonging and identity for all pupils, regardless of their protected characteristics or socio-economic circumstances.

This policy lays out the measures the school has taken to ensure a consistent, fair and inclusive uniform policy, and to implement a uniform that reflects the needs of all pupils. We believe that pupils learn most effectively and achieve their best outcomes when they are comfortable, able to be themselves, and dressed in a way that sets an appropriate tone for education.

The school uniform is as follows:

Grey or black trousers or knee- length grey skirt	Required	No branding	Available from regular retailers

Plain trainers	Required	No branding	Available from regular retailers
School book bag	Optional	School logo	Provided by school

Pupils who are wearing skirts will also be required to wear grey or black tights. Black jeans will not be permitted.

The school will not consider trainers or higher heeled designs as suitable school shoes.

A PE kit will need to be provided by parents but this can include the following and brands/logos from sports teams are permitted:

T-shirt

- Shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- Suitable trainers
- Other suitable sports footwear, e.g. football boots, if required
- An appropriate swimming costume

Parents are responsible for ensuring their child brings their PE kit to school when needed.
