Go on a nature walk and take 5 photos or draw 5 pictures of items that show it is early spring.
Create you own Mexican or Mayan themed book mark.	Robert Louis Stevenson wrote 'Treasure Island' a story about Pirates. Write a short pirate adventure story or a short description of your own pirate.	Research a famous inventor from any era, and create an information poster all about him/her.	Make a model of an Mayan temple.
Find out 5 facts about Queen Victoria - Perhaps take a photo of her statue in Worcester—if you can find it!	Plant a few Tomato seeds or seeds of your choice in pots to grow indoors ready for the summer!	Victorian children had to go to work!. Draw a picture or find out about what jobs they did.	Make/bake a cake!!! The Victoria sponge cake was named after Queen Victoria.
